### School Performance Information 2022

#### Part 1- Information relating to schools

The following information is a Federal Government requirement and pertains to the 2022 school year.

##### 1. CONTEXTUAL INFORMATION

Star of the Sea Catholic Primary School, Rockingham is situated in the centre of Rockingham and is easily accessible from the suburbs of Rockingham, Safety Bay, Waikiki, Warnbro, Baldivis, Port Kennedy, Shoalwater Bay, Cooloongup, Hillman and Leda.

As a West Australian Catholic school we are part of the system of schools supported by Catholic Education Western Australia (CEWA). At the local level we are integral in the life of the local parish of "Our Lady of Lourdes." A fundamental role that goes with that is to provide a faith education for the children of the parish school. We do this by delivering a Religious Education Program using units of work prepared by CEWA. These units are used in all WA Catholic schools. The core philosophy of the school is based on Gospel values. Class Masses are conducted on a regular basis and there are opportunities for the children to receive the sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist and Confirmation.

Star of the Sea is a triple stream school catering for children in our 3 Year-Old Early Learning Centre (ELC) through to Year Six. The school operates a 3 Year Old Early Learning Centre (open 5 days per week from 6am - 6pm) and a 4 Year Old Kindergarten Program (Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday) with 2 additional days (Thursday and Friday) that are optional. Out of School Hours Care and Vacation Care are available at the school.

We recognise parents as the first and most important educators of their children and parents are strongly encouraged to participate fully in the life of the school. There are many opportunities to do this, for example, by way of offering classroom assistance, volunteering in the canteen and being active members of the Parents and Friends' Association or the School Advisory Council.

We have every reason to be proud of the standard of education we offer and this is done in a friendly and caring environment. Every child is encouraged to reach their full potential through a broad curriculum which covers the areas outlined in the WA National Curriculum. The curriculum includes tuition in the specialist areas of Science, ICT, PE, LOTE (Indonesian), and Music. Support is given to integrating Information and Communication Technology into classrooms across learning areas. There is an instrumental program, a literacy intervention program for children with learning difficulties, specialised programs for those with special needs and also a challenge program. The school is well resourced and there has been a recent upgrade of computer infrastructure and facilities. All classes have smart televisions, and there are excellent sporting and playground facilities with a large oval.



## 2. TEACHER QUALIFICATIONS

In 2022, Star of the Sea employs 77 staff as teachers and teacher assistants. All teachers are suitably qualified members of the Teacher Registration Board of Western Australia and hold current Working with Children Clearance checks.

### Staff Training

## 4. STUDENT ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL

Average **Whole** (Pre-Primary to Year 6) School attendance for Semester 1 2022 was 91%. Indigenous students for the same period was 82%.

### Process for Dealing with Non-attendance

All absentees are recorded in the class Electronic Attendance Register by each class teacher. If a child is absent an explanation for absence is sought by texting parent or guardian. All absences must be explained in writing or by e-mail by the child's parent/guardian, and all notes are filed.



The classroom teacher regularly follows up any unexplained absences with a reminder note and/or phone call. Registers are reviewed each term to ensure correct procedures are followed. Where attendance is an issue, CEWA guidelines are followed. The situation is monitored and a discussion is held between the class teacher, leadership team, and parent/guardian. Communication is recorded on SEQTA.

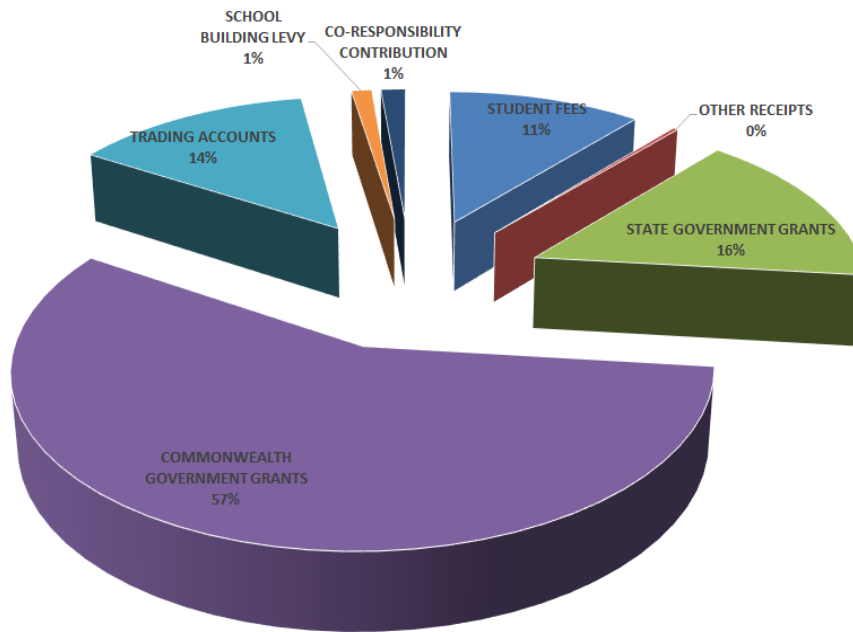
